Competition Pool: 6 Lanes Deep End. Continous Warm-Up/Down: 6 Lanes Shallow End Meet Rules:

There will be no scoring.

SNC rules and warm-up procedures will be in effect.

- Starts will be conducted from Starting Platforms (blocks) as per World Aquatics II.16.1.4 and 4.1.
- Swimmers may choose to start in the water or enter from a dive next to the starting blocks.
- The Starter shall report a swimmer to the Referee for misconduct taking place at the start of a race as per Swimming Canada Part II 2.3.2. The "misconduct" shall include but is not limited to (C.2.3.2.1): Deliberate or negligent acts such as spitting, spouting of water, or blowing the nose in the pool or on the pool deck immediately prior to the start may be considered misconduct. Deliberate kicking or striking of the starting platform, including the back plate prior to the start. Unsafe or uncontrolled entry into the pool immediately prior to the start of a race. All swimmers must enter the pool with a controlled, feet-first entry. The Referee may disqualify a swimmer for such misconduct.
- Swim Wear: SNC Swim Wear rules in effect.
- The meet will be swum as mixed gender, open events, timed finals.
 - An exemption from SNC rule SW 10.1 to swim events in gender separated events has been granted. In spite of this exemption, any swimmer who achieves a record time at this competition that recognizes records at any level (provincial, national etc.) will not be recognized for that record unless the coach has advised meet management via email by the entry deadline that there is a possibility of the record being broken, and the referee ensures that the swimmer competes with competitors of the same gender for his/her heat.
- Each swimmer entered in the AA meet must be graduated from Nova Tech Aqua Kids and be fully registered with Swimming Canada through their respective Provincial Swimming Office.
- 400/800 AA Freestyle events will require positive check-in.

Safe Sport: Swim NS believes that athletes, coaches, officials, support staff and volunteers have the right to participate in a safe and inclusive sport environment that is free of abuse, harassment, and discrimination. Details on Safe Sport during this event can be found here: Swim NS Safe Sport

Only registered swimmers, coaches, and officials in designated sessions of the meet are allowed on deck.

Photography/Videography: In order to minimize risk, all photographs and video taken at Swimming Canada/Swim Nova

Scotia sanctioned competitions, whether taken by a professional photographer or videographer, spectator, team support staff or any other participant, must observe generally accepted standards of decency. Under no circumstances are cameras or other recording devices allowed in the area immediately behind the starting blocks during practice or competition starts, or in locker rooms, bathrooms, or any other dressing area.
